

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2015
16TH DAY JULY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on September 8, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present. The Adair County Courthouse was closed on Monday, September 7, 2015 in observance of Labor Day.

Ashley Young from the City of Kirksville met with the Commission to discuss digging for Civil War artifacts in Memorial Park. They will use metal detectors to detect possible artifacts and dig small areas in the search. Mr. Young also said they will be going to the Bridle Farms to see if they can find anything. 2nd District Commissioner Mark Thompson moved to approve this archeological dig, and 1st District Commissioner Carson Adams seconded, with all in favor.

Adair County Collector, Sonja Harden met with the Commission to update them on the new credit card readers they had discussed on August 3. Mrs. Harden stated that after more discussion with the credit card reader company and Adair County computer technicians, she has decided to go with a different company. Mrs. Harden stated that she would like to go with Central Bank Company. This company will also charge 2.5% interest. . 2nd District Commissioner Mark Thompson moved to approve purchase of credit card reader service with Central Bank Company, and 1st District Commissioner Carson Adams seconded, with all in favor.
