ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2018 24TH DAY JULY ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on September 26, 2018 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present until 12:00 p.m. They were not in session during the afternoon due to the lack of a quorum.

At 9:00 a.m., the Commission met with Chad Earhart representing the Kirksville Leadership Institute (KLI) through the Kirksville Area Chamber of Commerce. Mr. Earhart stated that KLI places a focus on education, tourism, and government among other interests. Today, he wanted to share what they were doing in the community. KLI had several projects they could work on, but decided that beautification of downtown was an important way to attract people and business.

First, they were going to purchase hanging flower baskets that would be hung on existing lamp posts located on the sidewalks around the Courthouse. There will be five hanging baskets each having a wicking system with a 4 gallon reservoir. This will decease watering to once every 5 to 7 days. They will be taken care of by the KLI and the City of Kirksville who will also do the watering. Kirksville Downtown Improvement Committee will hang the baskets each year for the next five years. This covers the time frame of the warranty for the wicking system.

Second, KLI would like to illuminate the north side of the Courthouse with solar powered lights which have the capability to change colors. There will be three lights – two on each end of the building under the soffit shining downward and one in the middle mounted on the small balcony shining upward. Each light requires a solar panel and a battery pack. The solar panel will be installed on the roof and the battery pack housed in the attic. It is hoped that focused lighting on the north side of the Courthouse will spark community involvement to obtain funds to illuminate other sides of the Courthouse.

KLI is working with a budget of \$5,000 and are only a few hundred dollars short of obtaining their goal. With the permission of the County Commission, they would like to have the project completed by the spring of 2019. As this was a community project, KLI also requested permission to hang a commemorative plaque in the Courthouse with the names of all who have financially participated in the project.

The Commission thanked Mr. Earhart for his presentation and handouts of the project. They were appreciative of their interest to beautify the downtown area. All Commissioners were in agreement to endorse KLI's project and to hang a commemorative plaque within the Courthouse.

Mr. Earhart thanked the Commission for their time and support of the project. He will keep them informed of the progress of the hanging baskets and the installation of the solar powered lights.

The Commission received in the mail a Notice of Hearing on Formation of a Fire Protection District from Adair County Circuit Clerk, Linda Decker. The hearing is scheduled in the Circuit Court at the Adair County Courthouse at 10:00 a.m. on October 22, 2018 to determine if the question of formation of a fire protection district encompassing the boundaries of Adair County EXCLUDING the City of Kirksville, the municipality of Greentop and that portion of the La Plata Fire Protection District that is in Adair County should be submitted to the voters on April 3, 2019. A copy of the Petition for the Formation of the Adair Fire Protection District was attached.


