The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on July 14, 2014 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission attended the opening ceremonies of the Northeast Missouri Fair. The fair will be held thru Saturday, July 19th and will feature agricultural events as well as entertainment.

At 9:55 a.m., the Adair County Commission adopted the following resolution:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any business not covered by the stated reason or reasons for the closed session is raised during the closed session, that such business will be postponed until this meeting is reopened to the public and the sign for a closed meeting is removed from the doors of the Commission office. Present at the meeting were Presiding Commissioner Pickens; Commissioner Adams; Commissioner Thompson; Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop: and via telephone Adair County Legal Counsel, Ivan Schraeder of the Lowenbaum Partnership, L.L.C. So motioned by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Thompson with Commissioner Pickens approving at 9:55 a.m. on Monday, July 14, 2014.

Closed session ended at 10:15 a.m.

Adair County Treasurer, Lori Smith, submitted the Six Month Settlement for the first six months of 2014.

The County received the final 2014/2015 budget submission and the July minutes for the Adair County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC).
