

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2021
18TH DAY JULY ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on September 13, 2021, in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission had received notice that the final road improvement for the wind farm travel route had been completed with the installation of the turn chevrons on Trinity Way.

Commissioner King made a motion to approve the damage release. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion with Presiding Commissioner Shahan all in favor.

At 2:00 p.m., the Commission met with Jon Dwiggins of Howe Company, LLC to discuss Bridge #20400101 on Turkey Run. He wanted direction on the plans for Turkey Run and if it would be a County built bridge. He stated the county would receive soft match credit on the project. The bridge is included on the Missouri Department of Transportation's (MoDOT) deficiency list. All standards and thresholds would be the same, but planning and profiling the work, surveying the sight, alignment and the size will have a bearing on who builds it. After discussion, it was decided that Howe and Company would cease work on the engineering. They will contact them later in October and/or when numbers from MoDOT are received.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on September 13, 2021.
