The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on December 20, 2021, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. All Commissioners were present.


The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on December 20, 2021.


