

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY FEBRUARY 1, 2022
1ST DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on February 1, 2022, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:30 am, the Commission reviewed revisions to the Adair County Employee Manual. The first revision was to change what paid holidays the County observes. The policy now states Adair County observes all State of Missouri holidays. Prior to this, there was a list of observed holidays. The second revision was to allow victims of domestic or sexual violence to take unpaid leave from work for up to 2 weeks during any twelve-month period. Commissioner Thompson moved to approve the revisions. This was seconded by Commissioner Shahan. All voted in favor.

At 10:00 am, the Commission met with Derek Weber from the Regional Planning Commission. There was discussion on what the ARPA monies could be used for. Mr. Weber was going to do a survey in the community as to what the citizens would like to see some of the money used for. Mr. Weber was going to work on the survey and get back with the Commission.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on February 1, 2022.




