

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**MONDAY MARCH 14, 2022**  
**15TH DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 14, 2022, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. All Commissioners were present.

At 10:30 a.m. the Commission met with NEMR Telecom. Those present from NEMR: Kyle Rogers, Assistant Plant Superintendent; Michele Gillespie, General Manager; Travis Swarts, Project Coordinator; David Riddle Plant Superintendent. Also present was Sandy Collop, Adair County Clerk.

NEMR wanted to let the Commission know that they would be putting fiber from Hwy 157 down Hwy 6 to Potter Trl. and into the residential area around White Oak/Black Oak, Orrick Trl., continue along Potter into the city limits of Kirksville ending near Industrial Rd.

They stated the fiber would be 100 mg down and 20 mg up. They advised that bids would be opened on Wednesday, March 16, 2022, and they thought they would start sometime in the spring with construction.

NEMR stated they believed that they would be competitive because they would run single lines to each residence instead of the multiple lines off one single line which would give more reliable service and increased speeds. They advised that this would be paid from their existing revenues and no grants would be used.

They will advise the Commission when the kick-off meeting is scheduled.

At 11:30 the Commission reviewed a request for a speed limit of 25 mph on Orrick Trl and Cloud Trl. Commissioner Thompson moved to accept the speed limit request and Commissioner King seconded it. All voted in favor.


The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on March 14, 2022.


