The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on November 15, 2021, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. 1st District Commissioner William King and Presiding Commissioner Shahan were present. 2nd District Commissioner Mark Thompson was attending the Missouri Recycling Association Conference in Branson MO.

At 10:00 a.m. Commissioner King and Commissioner Shahan met with Howard Carter from Huber & Associates via the internet. Mr. Carter did a fourth quarter review of the County's computer security. Mr. Carter identified a few minor issues. The 2008 server needed updating and will be completed soon. Two accounts were found to be local accounts and needed to be domain accounts and upgrade another server from version 6 to version 7. There have been 919 service tickets opened with 907 service tickets complete. Overall Mr. Carter advised that the County computer system was in good shape.


The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on November 15, 2021.
