

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 20, 2021
8TH DAY OCTOBER REGULAR**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 20, 2021, in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Presiding Commissioner Shahan and Commissioner King were present. Commissioner Thompson was present until 10:00 a.m. then attended a County Commissioner's Association of Missouri (CCAM) meeting in Jefferson City.

The pre-construction meeting for Adair County Bridge #3160009-Titan Lane was held on October 20, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. in the Adair County Commissioner's Office. Those attending were Mike Schrage, BRS Construction LLC; David Ausmas, Howe Company; Betty Shahan, Deputy Clerk; William King, 1st District Commissioner; Mark Thompson, 2nd District Commissioner; Aaron Lukefahr, Howe Company; and Mark Shahan, Presiding Commissioner.

Mr. Lukefahr stated that the bridge on Titan Lane crossing over a branch of Bear Creek will include galvanized steel girders, a concrete deck, concrete abutments, driven steel pilings, guard rail, and earthwork.

He said that the work should start the beginning of November 2021 with the steel girders being set around the 1st of December. An approximate completion date is July 31, 2022.

The Project Superintendent on this bridge will be Doug Brown and David Ausmas, Howe Company LLC, will be the engineer. The Commission were provided contact information.


Presiding Commissioner Shahan signed the contracts and the meeting ended.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on October 20, 2021.


