The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 4, 2021, in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:00 a.m., the Commission met with Matt Buydos of Elliott Data Security. Also present were Adair County Sheriff, Eldon Grissom and Deputy, Jason Lene.

Mr. Buydos gave an overview of the services that his company could offer. Elliott Data Systems, Inc. has over one thousand clients and have offices located in St. Lous, Missouri, and Memphis Tennessee. They work with Sheriff Departments, Health Departments, and First Responders just to name a few. In Kirksville, they have Truman State University as a client. They also serve several Highway Patrol counties within Missouri.

Mr. Buydos stated that their system moves away from keys and uses one card for everything. Hardware is not proprietary. There is an integrated online access control system that can be expanded when needed. It is user defined and cards can be deactivated at any time. By using smart cards, the system is more secure. Cameras can also be incorporated into the system. His service is available thru State contract bidding.

The Commission thanked Mr. Buydos for the presentation.
