This Agreement entered into this 12th day of April 2022 between the County of Adair, State of Missouri and the Adair County Soil and Water Conservation District.





WHEREAS, the Adair County Commissioners are interested in making sure that the citizens of Adair County have ample opportunity to participate in soil conservation measures; and,

WITNESSETH:


NOW THEREFORE, for the mutual promises and covenants contained therein, Adair County and the Adair County Soil and Water Conservation District agree as follows:


