COUNTY OF ADAIR, MISSOURI RESOLUTION NO. 2022-2

A resolution of the County of Adair, Missouri, for purpose of funding 911 services, to impose a monthly fee on 911 enabled subscriber at the rate of \$1.00 per month pursuant to the authority granted by and subject to the provision of Section 190.455 RSMo; providing for submission of the proposal to the qualified voters of the County for their approval at a Special election called and to be held in the County on Tuesday, August 2, 2022.

WHEREAS, the County desires to impose a fee, as defined in Section 190.455 RSMo, at the rate of \$1.00; and

WHEREAS, the County is authorized, under Section 190.4955 RSMo, to impose a monthly fee; and

WHEREAS, THE PROPOSED County fee cannot become effective until approval by the voters residing within the county at a state general, primary, or special election.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Commission of Adair, Missouri as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Pursuant to the authority granted by and subject to the provisions of Section 190.455 RSMo, a monthly fee is imposed for the privilege of utilizing 911 services.

Section 2. The rate of the fee shall be \$1.00 per month per enabled subscriber.

Section 3. This fee shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the County of Adair, Missouri for the approval, as required by the provisions of Section 190.455 RSMo, at a Special election hereby called and to be held in the County, Tuesday, the second day of August 2, 2022. The ballot or submission shall contain substantially the following language:

QUESTION

Shall the County of Adair, Missouri continue to impose a monthly fee of \$1.00 on a subscriber of any communications service that has been enabled to contact 911 for the purpose of funding 911 service in the county?

O Yes O No

Section 4. The County Clerk is directed to take all necessary action to place the special election on the August 2, 2022 election.

Section 5. Within ten (10) days after the approval of this Resolution by the qualified voters of Adair County, Missouri, the County Clerk shall forward to the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri by United States registered mail or certified mail, a certified copy of this Resolution together with certification of the election returns.
