

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**WEDNESDAY MAY 25, 2022**  
**11TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on May 25, 2022, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:00 am, the Commission went to the Adair County Annex to meet with employees of McBride, Lock & Associates. LLC. Upon arrival, they met with Matt Brickey, Partner and Kateryna Kimbrough, Staff Auditor. Also present was Adair County Clerk Sandy Collop. Mr. Brickey explained that their company had been contracted by the State of Missouri to do the State's annual financial Audit. He advised that they should be in town for 2 weeks and then would finish their audit from the home office.

At 10:30 am, the Commission met at the new bridge located on Titan Lane to approve the acceptance of the work completed. Also attending was Mike Schrage from BRS Construction LLC, Shannon Howe from Howe Company and J.B. Hamlin, Adair County Road, and Bridge Supervisor. The bridge was inspected, and Commissioner Thompson moved to accept the bridge as built. Commissioner Shahan seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor. Mr. Howe informed the Commission that the bridge cost came in a little over \$8000.00 less than what was bid.

At 1:30 pm, the Commission drove several roads to check on their condition. They checked on Beechwood Trail, Youngstown Trail, Cadbury Trail, and Thousand Hills Trail. They returned to the office at 2:49 pm.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on May 25, 2022.
