## ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES MONDAY AUGUST 29, 2022 7TH DAY JULY ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on August 29, 2022, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. All Commissioners were present.

At 8:30 am, the Commission reviewed speed limit signs that were placed on Radical Ridge Way. It was found the signs were placed on the road by the County Commissioners when the Highway 63 by-pass was being constructed. This was prior to the speed limit ordinance being enacted in 2019. Commissioner King moved to enact this speed limit under the county's ordinance and that the speed be 30 mph on Radical Ridge Way between MO Highway 6 and Patterson Way. Commissioner Shahan seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor.

At 8:45 am, the Commission reviewed a performance agreement between the City of Kirksville and Kraft Heinz Foods. There was a contract to be signed by the Presiding Commissioner and the County Assessor attached with the performance agreement. The contract was reviewed by the county's attorney and the section where the County was required to collect the Payment in Leu of Taxes was removed. Commissioner Thompson moved to approve the contract. Commissioner Shahan seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor.

At 9:00 am, the Commission went to the Adair County Courthouse where they observed the repair and restoration of the Courthouse. They left at 10:00 am.

At 10:30 am, the Commission left to go to Memphis, MO for a BRO funding meeting. This was held at the Regional Planning Office. Six counties were represented at the meeting, and they decided which bridges to prioritize in the Region.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 pm on August 29, 2022.
