**1ST DAY JULY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on August 08, 2022, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. Commissioner Thompson was not present.

Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, reported unofficial Adair County election results from the August 2, 2022, Primary. There was a voter turnout of 24.84 percent.

Note: County Question 1 for Adair County appeared on all ballot types. Results are listed at the end of the election results.


Results of the Republican ballot were as follows:

Garner with 14 votes, Eric McElroy with 14 votes, Robert Allen with 13 votes, Robert Olson with 8 votes, Dave Sims with 7 votes, Kevin C. Schepers with 5 votes, Rickey Joiner with 4 votes, Russel Pealer Breyfogle Jr with 3 votes, and Bernie Mowinski with 2 votes, Dennis Lee Chilton with 2 votes, and Hartford Tunnell with 2 votes. United States Representative in Congress 6<sup>th</sup> District (Vote for 1): Sam Graves with 2,051 votes defeated Brandon Kleinmeyer with 237 votes, Dakota Shultz with 219 votes, Christopher Ryan with 154 votes, and John Dady with 37 votes. State Senator for 18<sup>th</sup> District (Vote for 1): Cindy O'Laughlin with 2,289 votes and no opposition. State Representative for 3<sup>rd</sup> District (Vote for 1): Danny Busick with 1,612 votes defeated Gary M. Ewing with 666 votes. State Representative for 4<sup>th</sup> District (Vote for 1): Greg Sharpe with 208 votes and no opposition. Presiding Commissioner of the County Commission for Adair County (Vote for 1) Mark Shahan with 1,670 votes defeated Jeff Gottman with 1,146 votes. Clerk of the Circuit Court for Adair County (Vote for 1): Martha Cole with 1,500 votes defeated Angie Sullivan with 1,237 votes. Prosecuting Attorney for Adair County (Vote for 1) David Goring with 1,509 votes defeated Patrick Nolan with 914 votes, and Andrew A. Boster with 356 votes. Treasurer for Adair County: Lori J. Smith with 2,397 votes and no opposition.

Senator for United States (Vote for 1): Paul Venable with 2 votes and no. opposition.



Also present on the telephone was Tim Sackman, lead security for Huber and Associates. Mr. Sackman stated there was two minor issues with the scans, but he said they were not significant and wasn't worried about them. He found twenty-four issues on the Dark Web. He said this was due to a data dump and he was not concerned about this either. On the ESS he stated that the employees need to do more training and they were working on getting everyone signed up. He stated that 40% of incoming emails were being blocked by the server. He stated that was a normal percentage. He said there were no issues with the silver scan. Overall, the system was secure. The meeting ended at 10:45.

At 11:15 am, the Commission went to Hazel Creek Lake to review the work on the new bridge. They returned at 12:00 pm.

At 1:30 pm, the Commission went to the Adair County Courthouse to review ongoing restoration and construction at the Courthouse. They left at 3:00 pm.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 pm on August 08, 2022.
