The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on September 26, 2022, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:00 am, the Commission had been contacted by the City in reference to them contracting W.L. Miller to resurface Shephard Avenue. There is a small portion of Shephard Avenue between the city limits and Hwy H. The city wanted to know if the County wanted W.L. Miller to pave that portion of Shepard that was outside the city limits. The Commission checked with their lawyer that advised that since the city had already bid the project, the County could work off of the city's bid. Commissioner Thompson moved to approve the paving. Commissioner Shahan seconded. All Commissioners voted in favor.

At 10:30, the Commission reviewed a petition to vacate Deerwood Trail. The Commission agreed to have a hearing on October 03, 2022.

At 2:45 pm, Commissioner King and Commissioner Thompson went to the Adair County Courthouse where they observed the ongoing restoration and construction. They left at 3:00 pm.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 pm on September 26, 2022.
