**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
MONDAY OCTOBER 17, 2022
6TH DAY OCTOBER REGULAR**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 17, 2022, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. Commissioner Shahan was not present.

At 9:30 am, the Commission discussed the appointment of a new member to the Adair County Library Board. Neither Commissioner felt comfortable on selecting anyone without first interviewing the applicants. Commissioner King moved to table the appointment until the applicants could be interviewed. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Both voted in favor.

At 10:00 am, the Commission met with Adair County Clerk, Sandy Collop, and Adair County Deputy Clerk, Tammy Miller, in reference to storage at the Adair County Courthouse. There was discussion about the 3 empty offices currently in the Courthouse and if they would be used as storage if needed. There was discussion about multiple different locations for possible storage. More study would have to be done before any decision could be made.

At 1:30 pm, the Commission went to the Courthouse where they cleaned furniture in preparation to moving them back into their office. They left at 3:30 pm.


The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 pm on October 17, 2022.


