

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 2, 2022
2ND DAY OCTOBER ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on November 2, 2022, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:00 a.m., the Commission reviewed Senate Bill 53 (SB53) which is in reference to a raise for Sheriffs in the state. The raise went into effect on January 1, 2022. There had been legal questions as to if the new law violated the Missouri Constitution. The Commission had been waiting for any legal opinions. The Commission is not aware of any further legal issues pending. Commissioner King moved to pay the Sheriff the pay and if it is later found unconstitutional, the Sheriff will be required to pay the monies back. Commissioner Shahan seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor.

At 10:30 a.m., the Commission went to the Adair County Courthouse where they observed the continuing work and restoration on the Courthouse. They left the Courthouse at 11:30 a.m.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commission reviewed ARPA requests. They reviewed Faith Lutheran Schools request #9 for \$435,728.81. Commissioner Shahan moved to pay the construction cost for the classroom that would be used for an aftercare program. This cost would be \$140,757.00. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on November 2, 2022.




