

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
MONDAY NOVEMBER 28, 2022
11TH DAY OCTOBER ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on November 28, 2022, at their temporary office located in the records storage building at the Adair County Road and Bridge complex. Commissioner Shahan was not present.

At 10:30 a.m., the Commission met with Kathy and George Patlakis about a road being closed. They were inquiring if Avenue A in the city limits of Connellsville was closed. They were advised that the road belonged to Adair County. The Commission looked at the road in question and it was actually grass with no gravel appearing. They were asked how long it had been since the road had been maintained. They stated more than 30 years. The Patlakis' were given a copy of Revised Missouri Statute 228.190 that states nonuse by the public for five years continuously of any public road shall be deemed an abandonment and vacation of the same. The Patlakis' wanted to know who owned the property since it was no longer a road. The Commission advised that they couldn't answer that question. They would need someone such as an attorney or a surveyor to give them that answer.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commission met with Derek Weber from NEMO RPC to discuss private business applications for ARPA funds. Mr. Weber went over the guidelines that were released about business applications. Mr. Weber stated he was going to work on a completely new application and should have it completed in a week or two.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on November 28, 2022.
