The Commission spent the rest of the day conducting county business.



The Commission spent the rest of the day conducting county business.





6TH DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on February 21, 2024, at the Courthouse located in Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 8:45 a.m., the Commission reviewed the bid for the 2-year audit ending 2023. Also present was Adair County Deputy Clerk, Tammy Miller. The 2 bids received were from Daniel Jones & Associates and McBride, Lock & Associates and had already been opened on 02-06-24. Adair County Clerk, Sandy Collop, requested the bid be awarded to Daniel Jones because she believed them to be more efficient and used their time wisely to initially obtain information with limited back tracking. Commissioner Shahan moved to award the bid to Daniel & Jones. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

At 11:00 a.m., the Commission had a zoom meeting with Ameren Missouri's BizSavers Program. The Commission spoke to Nathan Giessmann and Andy Painter briefly, but determined they didn't have all the savings numbers from the Courthouse project. They were going to do further research and get back with the Commission.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commission met with Adair County Clerk, Sandy Collop, and Adair County Prosecutor, David Goring, in reference to election security issues. Also present was Adair County Deputy Clerk, Tammy Miller, and Brad Ray, the County's IT representative.


Sandy Collop advised that the Secretary of States office did an election security assessment of her office and found 2 things she would like to address the Commission. First, she said that they recommended the security camera be moved from inside her office to outside her office. This was to ensure that no secure information could be viewed from the security camera.

Brad Ray stated that he was familiar with camera systems and that the cameras that we have were not good enough to read any information. He also stated that they could a privacy mask which would block out areas like computer screens. Tammy Miller stated that they had confidential information that they moved all over the office. Sandy Collop stated that it was a perception issue. Brad Ray stated the whole reason a camera was inside her office was for security in case something would happen. He also stated that if it was removed, someone could enter into her office from the Treasurer's Office, and no one would know.


Sandy Collop stated that person who did the assessment, Apollo, told her to move the camera outside the office and also told her that they had looked at the camera the camera was looking directly down at her monitor. David Goring stated that if the Secretary of States Office wanted it removed, then we should remove it. The Commission agreed.
