The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on April 22, 2024, at the Courthouse located in Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 10:30 a.m., the Commission reviewed the paperwork for the property located in Gibbs that belongs to ATSU. All documents have been sent and reviewed by the County's Attorney, Ivan Schraeder. Mr. Schraeder advised the Commission that the documents were in order and that they could adopt and proceed. Commissioner King moved that as soon as the County of Adair receives a Quit Claim Deed for the property from ATSU, that the property be signed over to the City of Kirksville and the City of Kirksville would pay the County of Adair \$10,000.00. This money would then be used for road maintenance in a 10-mile radius around the City of Gibbs, Missouri. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. No discussion followed. All voted in favor.




The Commission spent the rest of the day conducting county business.





The Commission spent the rest of the day conducting county business.




