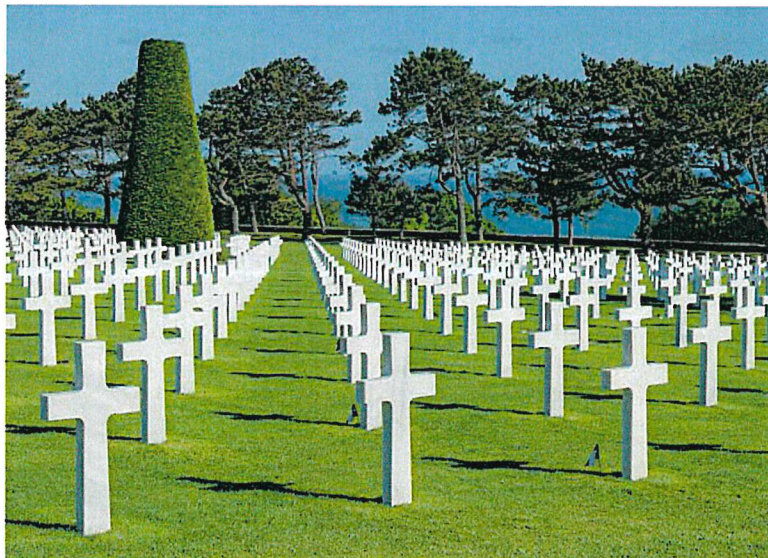
On June 20th, Family Heritage will be here and will stop by each office to discuss their products. I have attached a flyer at the end of this newsletter.

This year is the 80th anniversary of the Normandy Invasion. June 6th, 1944.

D-Day, also known as Operation Neptune and the Normandy landings, was the Allied invasion of Normandy, France on June 6, 1944 during World War II. The operation was the largest amphibious invasion in history, landing more than 150,000 troops on five beaches in Normandy by sea and air. The invasion was the beginning of Allied operations that would eventually liberate Western Europe, defeat Nazi Germany, and end World War II.

I am sure many of us had family members fight in WW2. I had two Great Uncles and a grandfather fight in the war. All survived, but the scars of war severely troubled one uncle all his life.
