TUESDAY JUNE 18, 2024
16TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 18, 2024, at the Courthouse located in Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:00 a.m., the Commission discussed some documentation from BNSF railroad about signal upgrade projects at Clemons Lane & Century Lane. BNSF wants to put up signals and gates at these intersections. BNSF had an open time for comments from the community and no one contacted them. The form that the Commission was reviewing was (State of Missouri form "Voluntary Waiver of Rights to Hearing and Consent to Issuance of Administrative order Authorizing Proposed Public Highway/Rail Crossing Construction or Safety Improvement Project). The Commission had contacted MODOT prior, and they did not see a need for a hearing.

Commissioner Shahan moved to approve the signing of the paperwork since there are no objections noted for the improvements to the intersection. Commissioner King seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

At 10:30 a.m., the Commission met with Apollo I.T. Consulting. Those not in person but attending on Zoom from Apollo were Betsy Schonhoff and Stacey Moskowitz. Those present in person were Chrissy Peters, Director of Elections from the Missouri Secretary of States Office, Adair County Clerk, Sandy Collop, Deputy Clerk Tammy Miller, and from Sprocket, Brad Ray.

Ms. Peters began with a background on Federal Funds received by the Secretary of State's Office for use in election security. The first round of the funding was used to do assessments of the County Clerk's offices and was voluntary. This had 95% participation from the Counties. Ms. Peters did advise that state statute now requires assessments every two years. Ms. Peters said these assessments have already been completed in all Counties.


The second phase was to pay for firewalls and monitoring. The program runs for 3 years with an additional renewal for 3 years. One of the reasons for the monitoring by the state is to ensure that no-one can access the States website which contains all voter registration information for the State of Missouri.

Ms. Peters advised that the only part of this that is mandated at this time is the assessments. She stated that the cost of the firewall and monitoring along with installation would be paid for by the State of Missouri. Ms. Peters said the State will pay for any issues identified in the assessment. She said that if there were IT issues found that affected all the County, the State would only pay for the portion that is associated with the County Clerk's Office.

Brad Ray wanted to know who was taking care of the equipment since it was not under the current contract with the County. He was advised that Apollo would partner with him and if there were issues that he must take care of that are associated with Apollo's contract, he would be reimbursed by the State. Ms. Peters stated that the State is unable to have relationships with every IT vendor and that is why they have an agreement with Apollo.
