If you make an appointment to see a doctor and are told that you are not in the system with Aetna, make sure the office is contacting GBS as instructed on the Card. There have been a few calls to me about this. They must call the correct number to verify coverage. See the attached flyer.

1 Call GBS to verify your insurance

2 Present your new ID card (sample below) at all visits

GBS has mailed ID cards to your home address. If you need additional cards, you can download/print copies on the GBS Portal or call us at (800) 995-3569.

3 What to tell your provider

Tell the provider your insurance has changed, and to please read your ID card to see how to verify eligibility and where to submit claims. **Do not contact Aetna** to verify eligibility or submit claims.

4 Aetna Signature Administrators® (ASA) is your PPO Network

ASA is your PPO Network, which is different than having Aetna as your insurance company. To find your in-network providers, you can view the provider directory at: aetna.com/asa

Mark your calendars because Kirksville's annual Red, White and Blue Festival is just around the corner, taking place on Friday, July 4 and Saturday, July 5.


The fun begins Friday night with the Summer on the Square Concert Series and United Way Pie-eating contest and auction.

Novinger Log Homestead and Coal Miners Museum open for touring

The Novinger Log Homestead and Coal Miners Museum will be open for touring from 2-4 p.m. on the last Sundays in June, July and August — June 29, July 27 and August 31 (Labor Day Weekend). The Log Homestead, located at Coal Street and Snyder Avenue, features a two-story log home built in 1848, along with a double-pen log barn, a log smokehouse and an outhouse. The log cabin is furnished with period items and local memorabilia. Visitors to the museum can trace the history of coal mining in the area from its peak into the mid-1900s. Located at 804 Corrigan Street (first left off Route O), the museum contains a simulated coal mine and blacksmith shop, antique farm tools, memorabilia from local businesses, etc. Private tours can be scheduled at other times by calling 660-342-6455.

Novinger Renewal is also planning an Ice Cream Social on Sunday, August 17 beginning at 2 p.m. in the Community Center. The log homestead and museum will also be open for viewing at that time.
