The Adair County Commission was convened at 8:30 a.m. on July 09, 2025, at the Courthouse located in Kirksville. All the Commissioners were present.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commission attended a zoom meeting put on by K-Redi with Mark Grim with Gilmore Bell. Mr. Grim explained how many counties are doing Chapter 100 bonds since the state hasn't moved on how to assess solar projects. Because there is no assessment available, the Solar Projects are currently not paying any property taxes. The Counties are agreeing to Chapter 100 bonds to receive PILOT funds. Mr. Grim answered several questions, most notably about decommissioning surety bonds.

At 3:00 p.m., the Commission met with Errol Hooper about an abandoned County Road. Also present was Adair County Road and Bridge Supervisor, J.B. Hamlin. Mr. Hooper advised that there was an abandoned county road that ran from MO Hwy AA to Morgan Road. In January of 2013, the Commission had been approached to formally close the road. Mr. Hooper requested the Adair County Commission leave open ½ of the road so that he could have access to some of his property that was land locked. At that time, the Commission did not officially close the road or open it back up.

He was now requesting the current Commission to formally reopen part of the road so that he would have access to his land locked property. Mr. Hooper stated he would pay to get the road back into shape. The Commission advised that they will contact their attorney to see how to properly reopen a section of the road.

The Commission spent the rest of the day conducting county business.




